

ORDER REQUIRING C. MONDAVI & SONS - KRUG WINERY,
NAPA COUNTY, TO CEASE AND DESIST DISCHARGING
WASTES CONTRARY TO REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED BY
THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL
BOARD, SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGION

ORDER NO. 72-92

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds that:

A. On August 22, 1972, this Board adopted Order No. 72-64 prescribing waste discharge requirements for C. Mondavi & Sons - Krug Winery, Napa County.

B. The discharge requirements provide in part as follows:

"A. Discharge Specifications

1. The treatment or disposal of waste "A" or "B" shall not create a nuisance as defined in Section 13050(m) of the California Water Code.

... ..

3. The oxidation ponds shall be adequately protected from erosion flooding and washout by waters of the Napa River. Adequate protection is defined as protection from a flood having a predicted frequency of once in 100 years.

B. Discharge Prohibitions

1. Overflow of waste "B" from the conveyance ditch, oxidation ponds and percolation trenches onto land which drains into the Napa River is prohibited."

C. Inspection and complaints received by board staff indicate that the discharger is violating and/or threatening to violate the requirements listed in "B" above.

D. On October 20, 1972, after due notice to the discharger and all other affected persons, a hearing panel of the Regional Board conducted a public hearing at which the discharger appeared and evidence was received concerning the discharge.

E. Upon the basis of the evidence received, the hearing panel recommended that the board issue a cease and desist order against the discharger requiring compliance with the requirements listed in "B" above pursuant to a time schedule.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- A. C. Mondavi & Sons - Krug Winery, Napa County, cease and desist from discharging wastes in violation of or threatened violation of requirements listed in paragraph B above.
- B. Compliance with the Board's discharge specifications A.1 and A.3 and discharge prohibitions B.1 setforth in Order No. 72-64 shall be completed in accordance with the following schedule:

- C. If, in the opinion of the Executive Officer, C. Mondavi & Sons fails to comply with the provisions of this order, the Executive Officer is directed to request the Attorney General to take the appropriate enforcement action against the discharger, including injunction and civil monetary remedies, if appropriate.
