ORDER NO. 80-15

WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AMENDING
ORDER 75-23 FOR:

CROCKETT MARINE SERVICE, INC.
PIER DREDGING AND SPOILS DISPOSAL
CROCKETT, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (hereinafter the Board) finds that:

1. The Board adopted Order No. 75-23 on April 15, 1975 prescribing waste discharge requirements for Dowrelia Boat Works to perform dredging and spoils disposal in the Carquinez Straits near Crockett, Contra Costa County. The Board amended said Order by adopting Order No. 78-2 on January 17, 1978.
2. By letter received March 3, 1980, the Regional Board was informed that Dowrelia Boat Works has changed ownership and that the official name of the new entity is Crockett Marine Service, Inc.
3. The dredging authorized by Order 75-23 as amended was not completed by the deadline of February 29, 1979 (Requirement A.1). The discharger has requested that the deadline be extended to March 31, 1985.
4. Order 75-23 as amended required that a monitoring program be conducted according to specifications of Corps of Engineers Permit No. 75-345-02 and that results be submitted to the Regional Board. Due to changes in dredge spoil disposal criteria, said monitoring program is no longer needed.
5. The Board adopted a Water Quality Control Plan for the San Francisco Bay Basin in April 1975 and this Order implements the water quality objectives stated in that plan.
6. The Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to prescribe waste discharge requirements for this discharge and has provided them an opportunity for a public meeting and an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.
7. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the discharge.
8. The discharge requirements govern the waste discharge from the maintenance dredging of a privately owned marina. This activity constitutes only a minor modification to land, and such activity is thereby exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act in accordance with Section 15104, Chapter 3, Title 14, California Administrative Code.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Order No. 78-2 is rescinded, and that Order No. 75-23 is amended as follows:

1. Requirement A.1 shall read as follows:

A variance from the Board's policy with respect to disposal of polluted spoils from the Crockett Marine Services Inc. Marina through an underwater diffuser as described in Order No. 75-23 shall not be permitted after March 31, 1985.
