



I am always disgusted by the amount of trash I see there. The Bay is filled with trash. It destroys recreation, impacts water quality, and kills marine wildlife. The Board's proposed permit would require cities and counties to meet a cleanup level of 100 pieces of trash for every 100 feet in a trash "hot spot" – this does not go far enough.
