Site Information

Waterbody: South San Ramon Creek (hot spot length: 1,500 feet)

Site Location: The portion of the South San Ramon Creek selected as a hot spot is the portion of the creek that is adjacent to Dublin High School. The high school is located west of S. San Ramon Creek. The Iron Horse Trail, which runs in a north south direction, is located east of the selected hot spot.

Justification

Information Supporting Selection as a Hot Spot (Attach additional photos as necessary):

This trash hot spot selection has been identified, through both Zone 7's and the City of Dublin's maintenance inspections, as having trash problems. This trash spot is located adjacent to the baseball field, football field and bleachers at Dublin High School. The City of Dublin has met with the Dublin Unified School District in the past to discuss the accumulation of trash that occurs at this location of the creek. The high school is likely the biggest contributor to the trash issue in this section of the San Ramon Creek.
