

Site Information

Site Location: Burlingame Shoreline, contiguous with the public San Francisco Bay Trail, beginning at approximately 1292 Old Bayshore Hwy (Easton Creek outfall) and continuing 900 feet north to the San Francisco Bay Trail entrance path, located just south of 1352 Old Bayshore Hwy.

Watershed: Easton Creek, Mills Creek

Waterbody: San Francisco Bay

Jurisdiction: Burlingame

Justification

Information Supporting Selection as a Hot Spot: Area accumulates litter from multiple sources. Public, mostly paved, San Francisco Bay Trail is traversed daily by a large number of users. Litter results from constant trail usage. Additionally, litter results from users of adjacent parking lots. Furthermore, San Francisco Bay currents carry limited debris to shoreline.

Existing Cleanup Efforts: Annual Coastal Clean Up Day; Limited partial clean up by some of the owners of several private properties located along the trail, chiefly hotels, car rental agencies and office complexes. Other types of businesses are also located along the trail.
