Justification

Information Supporting Selection as a Hot Spot:

El Zanjon Creek was selected prior as a trash hot spot. El Zanjon Creek is located in City Park with extensive public use. The other creek in San Bruno, San Bruno Creek, has very difficult public access near the creek itself and most of the open waterway flows through a canopy of dense brush and trees making the downstream area impassable.

Existing Cleanup Efforts: Cleanup by Parks crews is done on a regular basis. The Hot Spot Cleanup was thorough, analytical and when hand collection of trash was completed, when possible, mechanical sweeping equipment was used to clean natural debris such as leaves and seeds.
