NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region (Central Coast Water Board) is accepting input and comments on the 2014 Triennial Review of the Water Quality Control Plan for the Central Coastal Basin from July 30, 2014 to September 15, 2014.

Central Coast Water Board staff prepared “Brief Issues Descriptions” for the 2014 Triennial Review to explain the process, past priority issues and preliminary staff recommendations. Central Coast Water Board staff will hold a public meeting and workshop on the review and adequacy of the *Water Quality Control Plan for the Central Coastal Basin* (Basin Plan):

The purpose of the workshop is to provide information, answer questions, and listen to input from interested parties.

The Basin Plan contains water quality standards and implementation programs for water bodies in the Central Coast Region. A “Triennial Review” of the Basin Plan is required by state and federal law in order to review the adequacy of water quality standards (e.g., beneficial uses and water quality objectives) and other elements of the Basin Plan. The Triennial Review may also be used to determine if Basin Plan updates are needed to keep pace with applicable regulations, advances in science and technology, and physical changes in the Central Coast Region. This workshop is an opportunity for the public to alert Central Coast Water Board staff

of the water quality issues and concerns it believes require amendments to the Basin Plan. A quorum of Central Coast Water Board members may be present, however no action will be taken at the workshop.

After public comments are considered, Central Coast Regional Board staff will develop a priority list of issues to direct basin planning efforts over the next three years. The Central Coast Water Board will consider adoption of the 2014 Triennial Review resolution and priority list of issues in November 2014.

Comments Submittal

The Central Coast Water Board will accept written comments on the Triennial Review of the Basin Plan during a 45-day comment period from July 30, 2014 to September 15, 2014.
