Project Description	The purpose of this project is to repair and replace an existing storm drain pipe that failed in 2015/16, resulting in an eroded gully at the top of the creek bank.  The project activities include:  • Conducting 10 cubic yards of cut and 20 cubic yards of fill (including pipe backfill);  • Removing the existing catch basin, installing a new storm drain inlet, and installing approximately 35 linear feet of new 18-inch diameter underground storm drainage pipe;  • Placing approximately 7.5-feet of new storm drain, outfall, and rocked energy dissipater below top-of bank;  • Installing a willow mattress around and down the slope of the drain outlet/energy dissipater;  • Installing two trees and 23 shrubs at top-of-bank in and around the temporarily disturbed area;  • Monitoring the plantings for a 5-year period; and  • Conducting construction activities during the dry season without use of dewatering.  Proposed mitigation includes creating 0.043 acres and restoring 0.002 acres of riparian area.  The Santa Cruz County Planning Department filed an Categorical Exemption in March 2017
