Project Description	The purpose of this project is to stabilize and rehabilitate 500 linear feet of roadway and embankment damaged by several storm events to prevent it from any further slippage.  The project activities include:  Installing three drainage inlets along the northbound shoulder;  Installing a new 18-inch corrugated steel pipe down drain from the three inlets;  Removing a 5-feet by 463-feet segment of concrete lined trapezoidal ditch;
	<ul> <li>Re-grading and re-compacting the base material of the trapezoidal ditch, then relining the removed section with 6 feet by 463 feet if concrete line V-ditch; and,</li> <li>Reconstructing a 500-foot long, by 20-feet wide, by 3-feet deep segment of the northbound lane and shoulder.</li> </ul>
