Project Description	<p>The purpose of this project is to ensure public safety and continued public access to Pismo pier.</p> <p>The project activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Replacing 182 piles with steel piles;• Installing two new timber piles for a PG&E utility platform;• Relocating and upgrading the fire line, water line, and electrical utilities;• Removing and replacing decking, stringers, piles, caps, guardrails, and utilities in two phases; and• Recoating steel piles with a corrosion protective material and installing a protective coating over exposed steel caps and pile heads. <p>No compensatory mitigation is proposed for this project.</p> <p>The City of Pismo Beach filed a Categorical Exemption on December 5, 2016.</p>
