Project Description	The purpose of this project is to ensure that the drainage system remains functional, that storm water flows can reach the Andree Clark Bird Refuge, and that the sediment that entered the system during the Monterey Country Club construction is removed before the rainy season. The project activities include: • Plugging the culvert northeast of the storm water drainage ditch with a balloon pig to stop all irrigation runoff from entering the system; • Dewatering the area if the channel does not dry out in the next month; • Constructing a plastic wrapped gravel bag dam downstream of the culvert, before work will occur in the drainage; • Removing sediment in the western portion of the channel by hand, with the assistance of a vacuum truck; • Using an excavator in an area at the outlet to remove cattail roots and sediment; • Removing approximately 1,050 cubic yards of sediment and vegetation; and • Staging all equipment above the top of the bank. Planned compensatory mitigation includes preserving 0.44 acres of streambed. Caltrans filed a Categorical Exemption.

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
