	The purpose of this project is to provide a secondary access road to Highway 41, allowing for the expansion of grazing production and secondary emergency access. The project activities include: Creating a 12-foot wide, 12,000-foot long (2.27 miles) agricultural road; Installing six culvert crossings along the new road, three of which (Culverts 1, 2 and 6) are jurisdictional;
Project Description	 Using a 24-inch high density polyethylene (HDPE) pipe, measuring 54 feet long, for Culvert 1; Constructing a 3.9' by 5.9', and 50-foot long, corrugated steel box culvert for Culvert 6; Installing an 18-inch HDPE pipe, measuring 27-feet long for Culvert 2; Placing 2 cubic yards of riprap at both Culverts 1 and 2; Placing 24 cubic yards of riprap at culverts 6; and Using a bulldozer, grader, dump truck, water truck, and loader to complete project activities.
	Planned compensatory mitigation includes: restoring 0.004 acres of streambed and 0.099 acres of riparian habitat, and enhancing 0.064 acres of streambed and 0.186 acres of riparian habitat.
	The County of San Luis Obispo filed a Categorical Exemption on August 11, 2015.
