

DESCRIPTION: Proposed Basin Plan Amendment to Re-consider the Upper Santa Clara River Chloride TMDL and Consider Conditional Site Specific Objectives for Chloride

This notice is to advise any interested parties that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, will consider adoption of an amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan to reconsider the Upper Santa Clara River chloride Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) and consider conditional site specific objectives for chloride. Consideration of the proposed resolution will be at a public hearing to be held on December 11, 2008 at 9:00 A.M., at the Ventura County Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, 800 S. Victoria Ave., Ventura, California. Actions to amend the Water Quality Control Plan for the Los Angeles Region will be taken in accordance with a regulatory program exempt under Section 21080.5 of the Public Resources Code from the requirement to prepare an environmental impact report under the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.) and with other applicable laws and regulations.
