THE BOEING COMPANY, SANTA SUSANA FIELD LABORATORY, VENTURA COUNTY (FILE NO. 04-022)

Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, section 20250(b)(5) requires that regional boards shall specify in waste discharge requirements the elements of land treatment programs by dischargers who treat or dispose of wastes in land treatment waste management units. On August 28, 2003 the Regional Board received The Boeing Company's Application/Report of Waste Discharge (ROWD) to apply for individual waste discharge requirements for operation of land treatment units at Santa Susana Field Laboratory. The ROWD was determined to be complete on February 20, 2004.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Regional Board, at a public meeting to be held on May 6, 2004 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the City of Simi Valley, Council Chambers, 2929 Tapo Canyon Road in Simi Valley, California, will consider adoption of the enclosed tentative requirement and written comments regarding any or all requirements thereof. It is expected that the Regional Board will take action at the meeting, however as testimony indicates, the Regional Board at its discretion may order further investigation.

Persons wishing to attend the meeting are invited to contact Regional Board staff to confirm their participation, or are otherwise invited to comment upon the tentative requirements by submitting comments in writing to the above address by the close of business April 21, 2004. All comments must be received by April 21, 2004 in order to be evaluated by Regional Board staff and to be included in the Regional Board's agenda folder. Comments received after that date will be provided, ex-agenda, to the Regional Board for their consideration and may result in delay in consideration of the tentative order. Timely submittal of comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Regional Board staff is able to provide timely review, and that the Regional Board members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised.
