NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board) staff will hold public workshops on December 19, 2000 and December 20, 2000, to discuss proposed general Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the discharge of commercial and residential wastes to small commercial and multifamily sewage disposal systems with a maximum average daily flow of 20,000 gallons or less. The proposed general WDRs establish minimum standards for small domestic systems by including numerical limits for pathogens and nutrients, among others, in the receiving water downgradient of the disposal systems, prescribe a comprehensive set of monitoring, maintenance, and disposal requirements for the wastewater treatment and disposal systems. Additional requirements, including disinfection of effluent to protect the beneficial uses of groundwater and surface water, are also prescribed for disposal systems located in areas of shallow groundwater and/or coastal areas.

Draft general WDRs will be mailed to interested parties on December 5, 2000 for public review and comment. In order for the Regional Board to consider comments regarding the staff report, comments must be submitted in writing and received at the Regional Board's Los Angeles office no later than January 5, 2000.
