This amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan for the Los Angeles Region (Basin Plan) establishes a Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) for organochlorine (OC) pesticides, polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), and siltation in Calleguas Creek, its tributaries, and Mugu Lagoon. The TMDL sets numeric concentration-based targets for OC pesticides and PCBs in water, sediment, and/or fish tissue to ensure protection of designated beneficial uses. The specific pollutants addressed are aldrin, chlordane, dacthal, dichlorodiphenyldichloroethane (DDD), dichlorodiphenyldichloroethelyene (DDE), dichlorodiphenyltrichloroethane (DDT), dieldrin, endosulfan I, endosulfan II, endrin, hexachlorocyclohexane (alpha, beta, delta, and gamma BHC), heptachlor, heptachlor epoxide, PCBs, and toxaphene.
