

Revolon Slough and Beardsley Wash are part of a watershed spanning Ventura and LA counties and are listed under the Fed. Clean Water Act as not meeting water quality standards due to excessive trash accumulation which endangers organisms and habitat and impairs beneficial uses of the waterways. This Gov. Code 11353 filing amends the Water Quality Control Plan for the LA Region by establishing a TMDL for trash and setting numeric targets (ultimately of zero) for Load Allocations and Waste Load Allocations for nonpoint and point sources of trash, respectively. Point sources are specific outflows such as storm pipes or ditches. Nonpoint sources are land-extensive activities such as agriculture. The amendments also specify how responsible agencies may come into compliance with the targets and schedules for coming into compliance and for monitoring and reporting.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11353 of the Government Code.
