

UNCONTESTED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

AAF-MCQUAY, INC., GROUNDWATER REMEDIATION SYSTEM, TULARE COUNTY

AAF-McQuay, Inc. (AAFM) operates a groundwater cleanup system that discharges up to 0.72 mgd of treated wastewater to North Branch Mill Creek Ditch, a tributary of Cross Creek, and a water of the United States. The Ditch is an effluent dominated water body. The facility has been regulated by WDRs Order No. 98-200 (NPDES No. CA0082511). AAFM employs two granular activated carbon (GAC) treatment units to treat volatile organic compounds (VOCs) in contaminated groundwater underlying the facility. This project is exempt from CEQA in accordance with the California Water Code. (GEA)
