

**TEICHERT AGGREGATES MARYSVILLE, READY MIX CONCRETE FACILITY, Yuba County (Waiver)**

Teichert Aggregates owns and proposes to operate the new Teichert Ready Mix concrete batch plant, which is under construction at the Teichert Marysville aggregate facility in Yuba County. The concrete trucks will be washed on a lined concrete pad prior to leaving the facility. Process wastewater will be temporarily stored in two lined concrete sumps and a 10,000-gallon above ground storage tank prior to reuse as concrete make up water and for filling truck wash tanks. The concrete wash pad and sumps will be underlain by a leak detection system. Analytical data shows that concrete washwater is typically classified as “designated waste”; however, the proposed method of discharge exempts it from Title 27 under Section 20090(i). Staff have prepared tentative General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the discharge of concrete wastewater that is exempt from Title 27 under Section 20090(i). This tentative Order is currently undergoing public review. This Waiver Resolution contains the same requirements as the tentative General WDRs, and is intended to allow this particular Discharger to begin operation prior to adoption of the General WDRs. This waiver will be rescinded upon signature of a Notice of Applicability by the Executive Officer for coverage under General WDRs. Surface water drainage from the facility is to unnamed tributaries and the Yuba River. (JRM)
