Sulara Enterprises, Inc. (Discharger) owns a closed drilling mud disposal facility near Orland, Glenn County. The Discharger's mailing address is: Sulara Enterprises, Inc., PO Box 55577, Orland, California 95973. On 17 September 1999, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Regional Board) issued Cease and Desist Order No. 99-117 (the Order) for violation of Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 98-162. The Order requires the Discharger to conduct studies, and complete site closure. The Discharger has completed site closure and substantially complied with the requirements of Cease and Desist Order No. 99-117; therefore, the Order is no longer needed.
