**PUBLIC HEARING**

CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION APPROVING PRETREATMENT PROGRAM  
(National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System)

for

**CITY OF MANTECA  
WASTEWATER QUALITY CONTROL FACILITY  
SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) promulgated General Pretreatment Regulations for Existing and New Sources of Pollution, codified in Title 40, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 403. The State Water Resources Control Board and Regional Water Quality Control Boards received approval authority from the USEPA to administer the General Pretreatment Regulations on 25 September 1989.

On 29 March 2004, the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Regional Water Board) adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R5 2004 0028 (Order) for the City of Manteca Wastewater Quality Control Facility. The Order requires that the City of Manteca implement and comply with all pretreatment requirements contained in 40 CFR, Part 403, including implementing the necessary legal authorities.

The City of Manteca requested approval of its Industrial Pretreatment Program in accordance with 40 CFR, Part 403.9, et seq, and Provision H.21. of the Order. A tentative Resolution is proposed approving the Industrial Pretreatment Program.

A **formal** public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Water Board meeting which is scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Staff of Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board
- City of Manteca Staff

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the

Regional Water Board no later than **19 January 2006**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The proposed Resolution was issued on **19 December 2005**. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item must submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **23 January 2006**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **23 January 2006** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
