SUBJECT: Port of Stockton, Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System, San Joaquin County – *Consideration of Approval of Storm Water Management Plan* [Brett Stevens (916) 464-4642]

DISCUSSION: The NPDES permit to discharge storm water runoff from the Port of Stockton municipal storm sewer system was renewed in October 2004. This permit required the Port to develop a Storm Water Management Plan (SWMP) to reduce the discharge of pollutants in storm water to the maximum extent practicable. The SWMP is a comprehensive document that provides a schedule for the study of the source and effects of storm water pollution, and control measures to reduce pollutant discharge to surface waters. In March 2005, the Port submitted a SWMP that prescribed specific Best Management Practices and performance standards to be implemented.

Regional Board staff has reviewed the SWMP and found it to be in compliance with the municipal separate storm sewer system NPDES permit. Additionally, the SWMP was made available to interested parties for a 30-day public review. No comments were received.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the Storm Water Management Plan.
