PUBLIC HEARING

concerning

Consideration of Waste Discharge Requirements

for

**OAKWOOD LAKE WATER DISTRICT AND BECK PROPERTIES, INC.
SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

Oakwood Lake Water District and Beck Properties, Inc. are constructing a wastewater treatment system to treat wastewater generated in a new development located at 874 E. Woodward Avenue, Manteca. Wastewater will be treated to disinfected tertiary recycled water standards and will be applied to land application areas. Treated wastewater will be stored in lined ponds. California Sportfishing Protection Alliance has contested the Waste Discharge Requirements as non-protective and requested a public hearing on the matter.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Board meeting which is scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Staff of Central Valley Regional Board
- Oakwood Lake Water District and Beck Properties, Inc.
- California Sportfishing Protection Alliance

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **8:00 a.m. on 23 October 2006**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements were issued on 29 August 2006. Persons wishing to comment on the specific revisions to this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **8:00 a.m. on 23 October 2006**. Written evidence or comments submitted after

8:00 a.m. on 23 October 2006 will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
