Subject: Twin Bridges WDRs

Good Morning Katie,

SCEHD has reviewed the Tentative WDRs for the Twin Bridges Landfill and has the following comments and are delineated by the numbers used in your Order:

9. Edit: UP 98-20 lists conditions of land use for this parcel. So stating that it is "condition #39" instead of using the word "finding" is more appropriate. (This language also applies to the Information Sheet page 2)

9. "mill waste no longer exists". Although, there is approximately 30 acres of waste currently at the old mill site. It has not been closed-in-place to date.

10. The site was deemed inactive according to 14CCR in June of 2005, not in March.

The definition for "inactive" according to 14CCR, Section 18011(a)(14) states that an "Inactive site is a site that is temporarily idle, for a specific period due to known circumstance and not part of the normal operation pattern contained in the solid waste facilities permit".

Furthermore, SCEHD received a letter from TMS, Inc. on June 8, 2005, which states that "TMS at this time does not intend to import any fill into Twin Bridges Landfill under the current permit".

10. Edit: The section number needs to read "21110" in the first sentence.

The TBL has not accepted waste since March 2002.
