GRIDLEY WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT
BUTTE COUNTY**

The City of Gridley (Discharger) owns and operates the Gridley Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) located approximately 3.3 miles east of Gridley. The Discharger currently operates under Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. 99-089. The Discharger proposes to expand the WWTP capacity from 1.05 millions gallons daily (mgd) to 1.7 mgd. The WWTP consists of a headworks, aeration pond, polishing pond, and percolation/evaporation ponds. Upgrades to the WWTP will include a new headworks, replacement of the aerators and mixers, and upgrades to the interconnecting process piping and pond inlets/outlets. Surface water drainage is to the Feather River.

The hearing on this matter scheduled for 27 October 2006 has been rescheduled to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) meeting of **8 December 2006**. The written comment period for this agenda item ended on 22 October 2006 and no more written comments will be accepted. Interested persons will have an opportunity to make oral comments at the 8 December 2006 meeting. Revisions made as a result of the comment period are shown in the WDR in redline/strikeout. Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide oral comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Regional Board no later than **1 December 2006**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross-examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.

The procedures governing Regional Board meetings may be found at Title 23, California Code of Regulations, Section 647 et seq. and is available upon request.
