

**CONTINUATION OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
concerning

**NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0079367**  
**WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS**  
**AND CEASE AND DESIST ORDER**  
for

**PLACER COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF FACILITY SERVICES**  
**PLACER COUNTY SEWER MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 3**  
**PLACER COUNTY**

The Placer County Department of Facility Services (Discharger) owns and operates the Sewer Maintenance District No. 3 Wastewater Treatment Plant. Treated wastewater is discharged to Miners Ravine, a tributary to Dry Creek, the Natomas East Main Drainage Canal, Bannon Slough, and the Sacramento River. The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) renewal of existing Order No. 5-00-118 proposes a significant number of new effluent limitations.

A continuation of the public hearing held on 3 May 2007, concerning the tentative WDRs, will be held during the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) meeting scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Central Valley Regional Water Board Staff
- Placer County Department of Facility Services Representative(s), and
- California Sportfishing Protection Alliance

Only designated parties will have the right to (1) call and examine witnesses, (2) introduce exhibits, (3) cross-examine opposing witnesses, (4) impeach any witness, and/or (5) rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **8 June 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and, in particular, how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item and/or the tentative WDRs and CDO must submit testimony, evidence, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **8 June 2007**. Written and oral comments must be limited to proposed revisions contained in the June 2007 Tentative WDRs

that are identified in “underline/strike-out” text denoting late revisions regarding the following issues that are the basis of the continuation of the public hearing:

- Addition of a Compliance Schedule for Proposed Turbidity Effluent Limits,
- Addition of Compliance Determination Language for Regulated Flow,
- Addition of Organochlorine Pesticide Effluent Limits and corresponding Compliance Schedule, and
- Correction of technical errors in the calculation of the proposed Ammonia and Mercury Effluent Limitations.

Written evidence or comments submitted after **8 June 2007** or beyond the scope of the revisions denoted in “underline/strike-out” text will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals.
