The Henry Jongsma & Son Dairy is owned and operated by Henry Jongsma and is located in the southwestern portion of Section 9, Section 16, and the southwestern portion of Section 15, Township 21W, Range 2S, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, at 3724 County Road S in Orland, Glenn County. The waste management facility at the dairy contains two lined settling ponds, and one main storage lagoon used for irrigation of cropland.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed informal hearing item must submit evidence, if any, or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **23 July 2007**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **23 July 2007** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony will be limited in time by the Regional Water Board Chair.

An objection by a party, either in writing or at the time of the hearing, to the decision to hold a hearing not allowing cross-examination and rebuttal testimony by designated parties shall be resolved by the Board Chair before going ahead under the proposed procedures. Failure to make a timely objection to the use of the proposed hearing procedure before those procedures are used will constitute consent to those procedures.
