The City of Williams is a small community with a financial hardship. It has been unable to comply with a time schedule to upgrade its facility pursuant to Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R5-2001-0049 (NPDES No. CA0077933), and has accumulated numerous effluent limitation violations subject to mandatory minimum penalties pursuant to California Water Code Section 13385. The proposed Time Schedule Order requires full compliance with effluent limitations for BOD, total suspended solids, turbidity total coliform organisms, and ammonia, and other effluent limitations by 1 October 2010. The TSO provides an exemption from mandatory penalties for constituents subject to the Order.

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **6 July 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Time Schedule Order was issued on **14 June 2007**. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item must submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **6 July 2007**. Written evidence

or comments submitted after **6 July 2007** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
