SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

On 25 April 2003, the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Regional Water Board) adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R5-2003-0061 (NPDES No. CA0084848) prescribing waste discharge requirements and compliance schedules for the San Joaquin County Service Area 31, Flag City Wastewater Treatment Plant. At the same time, the Regional Water Board adopted Cease and Desist Order No. R5-2003-0062 (CDO), which set forth tasks and a compliance schedule for the Discharger to achieve full compliance with its permit. The Discharger has recently requested an extension of final compliance dates from 1 January 2008 to 1 July 2008 while it implements a project to discharge Flag City wastewater to the City of Lodi White Slough Water Pollution Control Plant. The Regional Water Board will consider a Resolution to amend the NPDES permit and CDO to provide until 1 April 2008, the end of the permit term, to achieve full compliance.

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Staff of Central Valley Regional Water Board
- San Joaquin County Public Works Staff

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **9 October 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Resolution was issued on **6 September 2007**. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item must submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **9 October 2007**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **9 October 2007** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross-examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
