NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

concerning

**RENEWAL OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
(NPDES NO. CA0082660)**

FOR

**CITY OF BRENTWOOD
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT
CONTRA COSTA COUNTY**

The City of Brentwood owns and operates a publicly owned Wastewater Treatment Plant that provides sewerage service for the City of Brentwood, serving a population of about 37,000 people. The Facility's design average dry weather flow capacity is 5 million gallons per day (mgd). The treatment system consists of a headworks (screening and grit removal), two extended aeration activated sludge basins, two denitrification basins, two secondary clarifiers, two banks of two single media filters (a total of four filters), a chlorine contact chamber, dechlorination, and a cascade aeration system. The Facility discharges tertiary treated effluent to Marsh Creek, a water of the United States. Periodically, the Discharger will use on-site percolation ponds for land disposal of secondary treated effluent.

The proposed Order includes new effluent limitations for selenium, persistent chlorinated hydrocarbon pesticides, and chloride.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Water Board meeting, which is scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Staff of Central Valley Regional Water Board
- City of Brentwood staff

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **17 January 2008**. The request must

explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements and Time Schedule Order were issued on **17 October 2007**. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than noon on **21 November 2007**. Written evidence or comments submitted after noon on **21 November 2007** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
