(National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit No. CA0079511)

**CITY OF SHASTA LAKE
WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY**

SHASTA COUNTY

The City of Shasta Lake (Discharger) owns and operates a wastewater treatment facility and discharges an average dry weather flow of 1.3 mgd of treated domestic wastewater into Churn Creek, a tributary to the Sacramento River. During the dry season, effluent is used onsite for spray irrigation, or is held in a storage reservoir. The treatment system consists of a mechanical barscreen, oxidation ditch, two secondary clarifiers, sand filters, chlorine contact basin, emergency retention basins, and a 400-acre-foot reclaimed water storage reservoir. Solids handling processes include aerobic digestion and sludge storage basins. Sludge is dried in the storage basins and disposed of offsite. The Discharger's mailing address is P.O. Box 777, Shasta Lake City, CA 96019. The discharge is regulated under an existing National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. The Discharger submitted a Report of Waste Discharge and requested renewal of the existing NPDES permit. Staff recommends the Regional Water Quality Control Board adopt the tentative NPDES permit to regulate the discharge from the facility.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) meeting, which is scheduled for:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the

Regional Board no later than **noon on 6 February 2008**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item must submit evidence and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **noon on 6 February 2008**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **noon on 6 February 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record, unless the Regional Board agrees to accept the evidence or comments and if doing so would not prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross-examination will be limited in time by the Regional Board Chair.
