**STALLION SPRINGS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT  
WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY  
KERN COUNTY**

The Stallion Springs Community Services District (District) owns and operates a wastewater collection, treatment, and disposal system, and provides sewerage service to a portion of the unincorporated community of Stallion Springs in Kern County. The District's wastewater treatment facility discharges secondary-treated wastewater under a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit to Chanac Creek, a water of the United States. The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) will consider renewal of NPDES Permit No. CA0080489 to authorize continued discharge. The proposed permit contains new interim and final effluent limitations for copper and ammonia.

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Staff of Regional Water Board
- Stallion Springs Community Services District

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than noon on **7 May 2008**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than by noon on **7 May 2008**. Written evidence or comments submitted after noon

on **7 May 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
