CASCADE SHORES WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT
NEVADA COUNTY**

Nevada County Sanitation District No. 1 (Discharger) owns and operates the Cascade Shores Wastewater Treatment Plant, which provides tertiary treatment for up to 0.026 mgd of domestic wastewater from a portion of the Cascade Shores Subdivision. The Discharger is proposing construction of a new wastewater treatment facility at a new location away from the unstable hillside above the existing treatment facility. Treated wastewater is discharged to Gas Canyon Creek, an ephemeral stream tributary to Greenhorn Creek and Rollins Reservoir, a tributary to Bear River.

The Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) will consider renewal of the Discharger's existing NPDES Permit, proposing more restrictive effluent limitations for Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD) and Total Suspended Solids (TSS) and new effluent limitations for Aluminum, Copper, and Dichlorobromomethane. A Cease and Desist Order is also proposed to include a compliance schedule for Ammonia, Nitrate, and Total Coliform Organisms.

Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on **8 July 2008**. The

request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on **8 July 2008**. Written evidence or comments submitted after 5:00 p.m. **8 July 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
