**CITY OF DAVIS
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT
YOLO COUNTY**

The City of Davis (Discharger) owns and operates a wastewater treatment plant that provides sewage service to the community of Davis. The Facility discharges to the Willow Slough Bypass and the Conaway Ranch Toe Drain and is currently regulated by Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. R5-2007-0132, adopted on 25 October 2007. The adopted WDR Order contains time schedules of up to eight years for the Discharger to comply with new and more stringent effluent limitations. To consider wastewater reuse to neighboring lands for agricultural irrigation purposes, the Discharger is requesting a two-year extension to corresponding time schedules in WDR Order No. R5-2007-0132.

A public hearing concerning a proposed amendment to WDR Order R5-2007-0132 will be held during the Regional Water Board meeting scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Regional Water Board Staff, and
- City of Davis Representatives

Only designated parties will have the following rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **22 January 2009**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and, in particular, how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Only public comments pertaining to the proposed time schedule extension, as identified in the tentative WDR Order Amendment with underline and strikeout font, will be considered during this public comment period. Persons wishing to comment on this hearing item must submit testimony, evidence, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on **9 January 2009**. Written evidence or comments submitted after 5:00 p.m. on **9 January 2009**, or not pertaining to the proposed time schedule extension will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
