I am a California resident who enjoys traveling to different parts of the Sierra Nevada for opportunities to hike and climb in wild mountains and swim in clear lakes. I am writing today to support a winter wet season closure of the Rubicon Trail.

The Rubicon Trail has gained wide notoriety as an off-road vehicle destination. Management of the Trail should maintain access to the popular route, while still protecting the natural resources that the Trail travels past. Using gates to enforce a winter wet season closure would be one of the most cost-effective ways to protect those resources.

I would also support additional regulation of motorized vehicles on the Rubicon Trail, including requiring cleanup of all oil spills, enforcing existing boundaries for motorized travel, and monitoring erosion control measures.
