
Re: Draft Cleanup and Abatement Order, Rubicon Trail, El Dorado County

I am writing to express my strong support for the above referenced action by the regional water quality control board. As a resident of El Dorado County, I have been extremely concerned about the discharge of sediments and wastes on and around the Rubicon Trail due to uncontrolled motor vehicle use. Many of these contaminants find their way into nearby creeks and streams, especially when motor vehicle use is allowed during wet weather conditions. This issue must be addressed, as you rightly point out.

I strongly believe that the cleanup and abatement order issued by your office will go a long way toward correcting the above mentioned problems. I urge El Dorado County officials to begin at once to correct these problems.
