WILLOWS WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative Order to rescind Cease and Desist Order No. R5-2006-0010, City of Willows and ECO Resources, Inc., Willows Wastewater Treatment Plant in Glenn County. The Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, (Regional Board) will consider rescission of the Cease and Desist Order at a meeting to be held on **23/24 April 2009**.

The Notice of Public Hearing and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. Regulations require that the Discharger publish the Notice in a local newspaper for one day, commencing no later than **13 February 2009**. The expense of publication is to be paid by the Discharger. Additionally, by **13 February 2009** post one (1) copy at the Notice at:

- The nearest city hall or county courthouse
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed), and
- The public entrance of the Willows Wastewater Treatment Plant

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **20 February 2009**. Proof of publication shall consist of an affidavit from the newspaper along with a copy of the published notice.



Any comments you may have concerning the enclosed tentative documents must be submitted to this office by **noon on 13 March 2009**. Please note that the tentative documents will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period. In order to conserve paper and reduce mailing costs, paper copies of the enclosures are being transmitted to the dischargers only.
