## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING** concerning

### **TENTATIVE ORDER R5-2009-XXXX AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R5-2008-0069 WAIVING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR**

### **COFFMAN SPECIALTIES, INC. AND TEICHERT CONSTRUCTION COMPANY BOREAL TEMPORARY BATCH PLANT AND CONCRETE /ASPHALT RECYCLING SITE NEVADA COUNTY**

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, (Central Valley Water Board) adopted Resolution No. R5-2008-0069 waiving Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for Coffman Specialties, Inc. and Teichert Construction Company Boreal Temporary Batch Plant and Concrete /Asphalt Recycling Site, Nevada County (Facility). The Facility is a temporary batch plant and recycling site that is used to produce materials to complete the California Department of Transportation Interstate-80 surface improvements and is permitted to discharge wastewater generated from the production of Portland cement concrete, and the cleaning of trucks used to transport the concrete.

The concrete batch plant operates from May through October. No equipment is stored or material stockpiled during the winter months. The discharger temporarily stores and recycles all wastewater generated from the concrete batch plant. Washwater is contained in a steel washout basin underlain by a secondary containment area designed to collect and contain the concrete washwater for proper reuse or off-site disposal. The solid material collected in the washout basin is temporarily placed in the solids disposal area and hauled in a dry state to an on-site concrete recycler.

The Central Valley Water Board will consider adoption of an Order amending Resolution No. R5-2008-0069. The proposed Order modifies the expiration date of the waiver of WDRs from 1 November 2009 to 1 November 2012. This action recognizes the need for flexibility in the construction schedule while not exceeding the statutory requirement of a 5-year life for a waiver of WDRs. Other date modifications have been made to Findings 10 and 13, and the Resolution has been reformatted to match an order.
