The City of Stockton and the County of San Joaquin (Permittees) developed a Storm Water management Program (SWMP) to comply with their National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) area-wide municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) Phase 1 permit, adopted by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) 6 December 2007. The tentative SWMP describes how the Permittees will implement Best Management Practices to control the discharge of pollutants from their MS4 to the Maximum Extent Practicable (MEP). The tentative SWMP would provide the Permittees with adequate legal authority to enforce against water pollution violations within their jurisdictions. If adopted, the SWMP will be implemented throughout the permit period (2007-2012).

Only designated parties will have the right to call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, cross-examine opposing witnesses, impeach any witness, and rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **31 August 2009**. The

request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and, in particular, how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative SWMP was issued on **23 July 2009**. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than noon **31 August 2009**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **31 August 2009** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.
