SUBJECT: County of Tuolumne and the County of Tuolumne  
Department of Public Works Division of Solid Waste, Jamestown  
Municipal Solid Waste Landfill Facility, Tuolumne County

BOARD ACTION: Consideration of the Rescission of Cease and Desist  
Order R5-2006-0100

BACKGROUND: In May 2005, the Tuolumne County Public Works  
Department attempted to close the Jamestown Landfill by installing an  
engineered clay cover. However, by December 2005, the cover slowly  
began to slide down the western slope. On 20 July 2006 the Discharger  
submitted its final construction report, but because of the slope failure,  
staff rejected the report.

On 22 September 2006, the Central Valley Water Board issued Cease  
and Desist Order R5-2006-0100 that required the Discharger to redesign  
and construct an entirely new cover, and resubmit a final construction  
report that complied with Title 27.

On 31 July 2008, the Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements  
Order R5-2008-0124 which approved the new design. Within six months,  
the final cover had successfully been reconstructed. On 24 September  
2009, staff conducted the final construction inspection and the Discharger  
submitted its final construction report on 1 October 2009. At this time, the  
Discharger has complied with all requirements of Cease and Desist Order  
R5-2006-0100.
