I am a Bear Valley Water District ratepayer, and I express my strong support for the NPDES requiring secondary treatment. As you know, the discharge has very unique characteristics and is likely only under extreme conditions (1-in-100 or even less frequently). Our effluent is already tertiary under current conditions, and it is the District's policy to discharge only in emergencies, with no discharge in over ten years. According to the current NPDES permit, secondary treatment is the basis of the current NPDES permit.
