Dear Mr. Marshall,

My husband and I have owned a house in Bear Valley since 1984. We have followed closely the debate concerning secondary or tertiary treatment to our effluent, and feel strongly that in Bear Valley's circumstances secondary treatment is more than adequate.

We therefore strongly support the NPDES permit draft requiring secondary treatment.

Obviously if there had ever been, or was now, a real danger of effluent discharge causing harm to the public we might feel differently. But the evidence points the other way. The harm done to the community of Bear Valley by an unnecessary requirement for a tertiary treatment plant would be incalculably high.
