TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (NPDES No. CA0082066) for Sierra Pacific Industries, Inc., Anderson Division. To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the tentative Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 23 June 2011**. Written materials submitted after this date and time will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative documents will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

This item was previously scheduled to be considered at the Central Valley Water Board's April 2011 Board meeting, but was pulled from the Agenda due to the lack of a voting quorum.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its 3/4/5 August 2011 Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. **By 24 May 2011** post one (1) copy of the Notice of Public Hearing at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by 27 May 2011. To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative documents to the discharger only. Interested persons are advised that the full text of the tentative documents is available on the Central Valley Water Board's web site at http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/centralvalley/board_decisions/tentative_orders/.
