Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the Sworlco Land Application Site in Tulare County, operated and/or owned by the City of Lindsay, Sworlco, LP, and Edward and Edna Brower Revocable Trust. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative WDRs at its 5/6/7 December 2012 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative WDRs must be submitted to this office by **5:00 pm on 8 October 2012**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
