**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE ORDER**  
**(NPDES PERMIT CA0084620)**

**CALAVERAS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AND**

**COPPER COVE WASTEWATER RECLAMATION FACILITY**  
**CALAVERAS COUNTY**

On 31 May 2013, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) is scheduled to adopt an NPDES permit renewal, which will renew Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order R5-2006-0081. The renewed NPDES permit prescribes waste discharge requirements for the Calaveras County Water District and Saddle Creek Golf Course, L.P. (Discharger), Copper Cove Wastewater Reclamation Facility (Facility). The Facility consists of a 0.2 million gallon per day (mgd) secondary treatment plant and a 0.95 mgd tertiary treatment plant. Effluent from the tertiary treatment plant is used for irrigation of the Saddle Creek Golf Course and maintaining water levels in federal jurisdictional wetlands within the golf course.

The Central Valley Water Board will consider a new 3-year time schedule for compliance with final effluent limitations for ammonia and nitrate plus nitrite required in the NPDES permit. The Discharger submitted an infeasibility analysis demonstrating that a compliance schedule is necessary to comply with the final effluent limitations and is as short as practicable.

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Calaveras County Water District
- Saddle Creek Golf Course, L.P.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **21 June 2013**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and, in particular, how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

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The proposed Time Schedule Order was issued on 22 May 2013. Persons wishing to comment on the noticed hearing item must submit testimony, evidence, and/or comments in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on **21 June 2013**. Written evidence or comments submitted after 5:00 p.m. on **21 June 2013** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
