Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District (Discharger) owns and operates the Sacramento Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant (Facility). The Discharger provides wastewater treatment service to the Cities of Sacramento, Folsom, West Sacramento, and the Sacramento Area Sewer District. The Sacramento Area Sewer District service area includes the Cities of Elk Grove, Rancho Cordova, Citrus Heights, and portions of the unincorporated areas of Sacramento County. The population served is approximately 1.3 million people. The Facility is permitted to discharge 181 million gallons per day of treated wastewater to the Sacramento River within the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta.

On 9 December 2010, the Central Valley Water Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2010-0114 (NPDES Permit) and Time Schedule Order (TSO) R5-2010-0115 which were subsequently amended on 1 December 2011, prescribing waste discharge requirements for the Facility. An order is proposed, in part, to modify the Monitoring and Reporting Program, modify the effluent limitations for dichlorobromomethane (DCBM) and chlorodibromomethane (CDBM), and remove the effluent limitations for N-nitrosodimethylamine (NDMA) in the NPDES Permit. The proposed Order also removes the compliance schedule and interim effluent limits for NDMA in the TSO.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) meeting, which is scheduled for:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m.** on **14 August 2013**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
