**PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice of Application for Modification of Waste Discharge Requirements  
(National Pollution Discharge Elimination System Permit No. CA0083861)  
for

**THE BOEING COMPANY  
INACTIVE RANCHO CORDOVA TEST SITE  
GROUNDWATER EXTRACTION AND TREATMENT SYSTEMS  
SACRAMENTO COUNTY**

The Boeing Company currently discharges treated groundwater from two Groundwater Extraction and Treatment (GET) Systems to Morrison Creek or tributaries to Morrison Creek. Recent construction of a stormwater collection conveyance pipeline along Douglas Road has disrupted Boeing's ability to send water from four extraction wells south of Douglas Road to its SGSA GET north of Douglas Road. To rectify this, Boeing has constructed a satellite treatment system, Admin GET south of Douglas Road to treat the water from those five extraction wells. The treated water is discharged to a stormwater retention basin that discharges to a southern branch of Morrison Creek. The permit is being revised to add this additional treatment plant and discharge point. It also eliminates the analysis for chlorine in the effluent from the SGSA GET as chlorine is no longer used to as a biocide at the facility. The permitted flow from the SGSA GET has also been decreased to account for the flow sent to the new Admin GET. Effluent limitations have not been changed.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed informal hearing item must submit evidence, if any, or comments in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **1 November 2013**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **1 November 2013** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All interested persons may speak at the Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony will be limited in time by the Board Chair.

An objection by a party, either in writing or at the time of the hearing, to the decision to hold an **informal** hearing shall be resolved by the Board Chair before going ahead under the informal procedure. Failure to make a timely objection to the use of informal hearing procedures before those procedures are used will constitute consent to an informal hearing.
