TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and a Time Schedule Order (TSO) for an existing grape juice processing plant owned by Delano Growers Grape products in Delano, Kern County. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative WDRs and TSO at its 5/6 June 2014 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative WDRs or TSO must be submitted to this office by **5:00 p.m. on 4 April 2014**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
