TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for Del Monte Foods, Inc., Plant #24 in Hanford, Kings County. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative WDRs at its 9/10 October 2014 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative WDRs must be submitted to this office by **5:00 p.m. on 20 August 2014**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
