The Central Valley Water Board will consider these and any appropriate oral testimony at the scheduled public hearing. The Central Valley Water Board may elect to adopt a WDRs/NPDES Permit and Time Schedule Order R5-2011-0904 rescission that differs from the recommended WDRs/NPDES Permit and Time Schedule Order R5-2011-

0904 rescission and may do so without another public comment period if determined to be consistent with applicable laws and regulations.
